

**Beanpot Committee Announce 2022 Hall of Fame Inductee** 

Boston, MA (Jan. 28, 2022) - Jim Madigan, who played a part in six of Northeastern's seven Beanpot championships, has been named the 2022 Beanpot Hall of Fame inductee. He is the 15<sup>th</sup> Northeastern representative to be inducted into the Hall of Fame.

Madigan, now the Director of Athletics and Recreation at Northeastern, won two Beanpot titles as a player (1984, 1985), one as an assistant coach (1988) and three as a head coach (2018, 2019, 2020). He is one of just three people in tournament history to win a Beanpot as a player, assistant coach and head coach (Boston University's Jack Parker and David Quinn).

Madigan also guided the Huskies to their first of three consecutive Beanpot titles in 2018, ending a 30-year drought. As a head coach, he was 11-7 (.611) in the Beanpot.

Madigan will be presented with this award during an on-ice ceremony prior to the Beanpot Tournament Championship game on Monday, February 14, 2022 at TD Garden.
